



### TECHNICAL BULLETIN SPRAYED GLASS APPEARANCE TYPES

TRANSPARENT SPRAY	Clear or color that you can see through.	
TRANSLUCENT SPRAY	Allowing light to pass through, but only diffusely, so that objects on the other side cannot clearly be seen.	
FROST SPRAY	Where the glass appears to be etched, but it's sprayed. Can be colorless, or you can add color.	
OPAQUE SPRAY	Impervious to light, so that images cannot be seen through it.	
MATTE SPRAY	Same as opaque, but with a dull finish.	

#### THERE ARE MULTIPLE WAYS AN ITEM CAN BE SPRAYED:

- FULL SPRAY** The entire outside of the glass is sprayed.
- BOTTOM SPRAY** Only the bottom of the glass is sprayed.
- FEATHER SPRAY** Where only a portion of the glass is sprayed, usually from bottom up.
- INSIDE SPRAY** Where the inside of the glass is sprayed. Only done for candles; not for drinkware.
